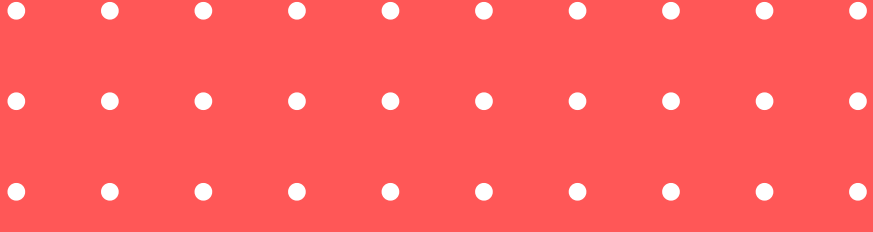
We are expectant for the year ahead and confident that God is leading us into something good.

## Stepping Into a New Season of Leadership in Worship Ministry

In every thriving ministry, there comes a time when growth requires structure — not to restrict vision, but to support it.

As we step into this new season, our worship ministry is embracing a leadership model built on collaboration, empowerment, and shared responsibility. While there is oversight in place, this is not about one person being “in charge.” Instead, it’s about raising leaders, building strong teams, and ensuring that no one carries the weight alone.

### A Leadership Model That Multiplies Leaders

The reality is simple: there is too much to be done for one person to do it all — and that’s a good thing. Growth is evidence of health.

Rather than centralizing responsibility, the vision is to delegate intentionally and develop leaders within each area of ministry. Our worship ministry is made up of four key teams:

- Music
- Livestream
- Projector
- Sound

Each of these areas plays a vital role in creating an atmosphere where people can encounter God — both in the room and online. To strengthen these teams, we are establishing (and in some cases affirming) team captains for each area.

If you have experience, passion, or a willingness to grow in any of these areas, there is space for you — not just to serve, but to lead. Leadership here is not about titles; it's about stewardship, responsibility, and empowering others to succeed.

## Support, Development, and Administration

This new leadership structure is not about adding pressure — it's about providing support.

The role of this new leader will focus on:

- Developing skills within each team
- Ensuring equipment needs are addressed
- Strengthening administrative systems
- Creating clear communication pathways

In addition, ***there will be proper documentation of all ministry assets***. Every piece of equipment, every resource available to the team will be recorded and organised. Clarity creates accountability, and accountability strengthens stewardship.

## Shared Pastoral Care Through Connection

To help with scheduling and rostering, we will be implementing Planning Center. This will streamline communication, scheduling, and coordination so that everyone knows when they are serving and what is expected.

Organization allows creativity to flourish. When systems are strong, ministry becomes smoother, and people can focus on what truly matters.

An invitation to grow in skill and character.

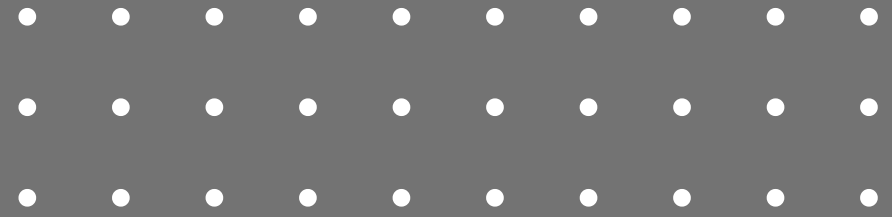
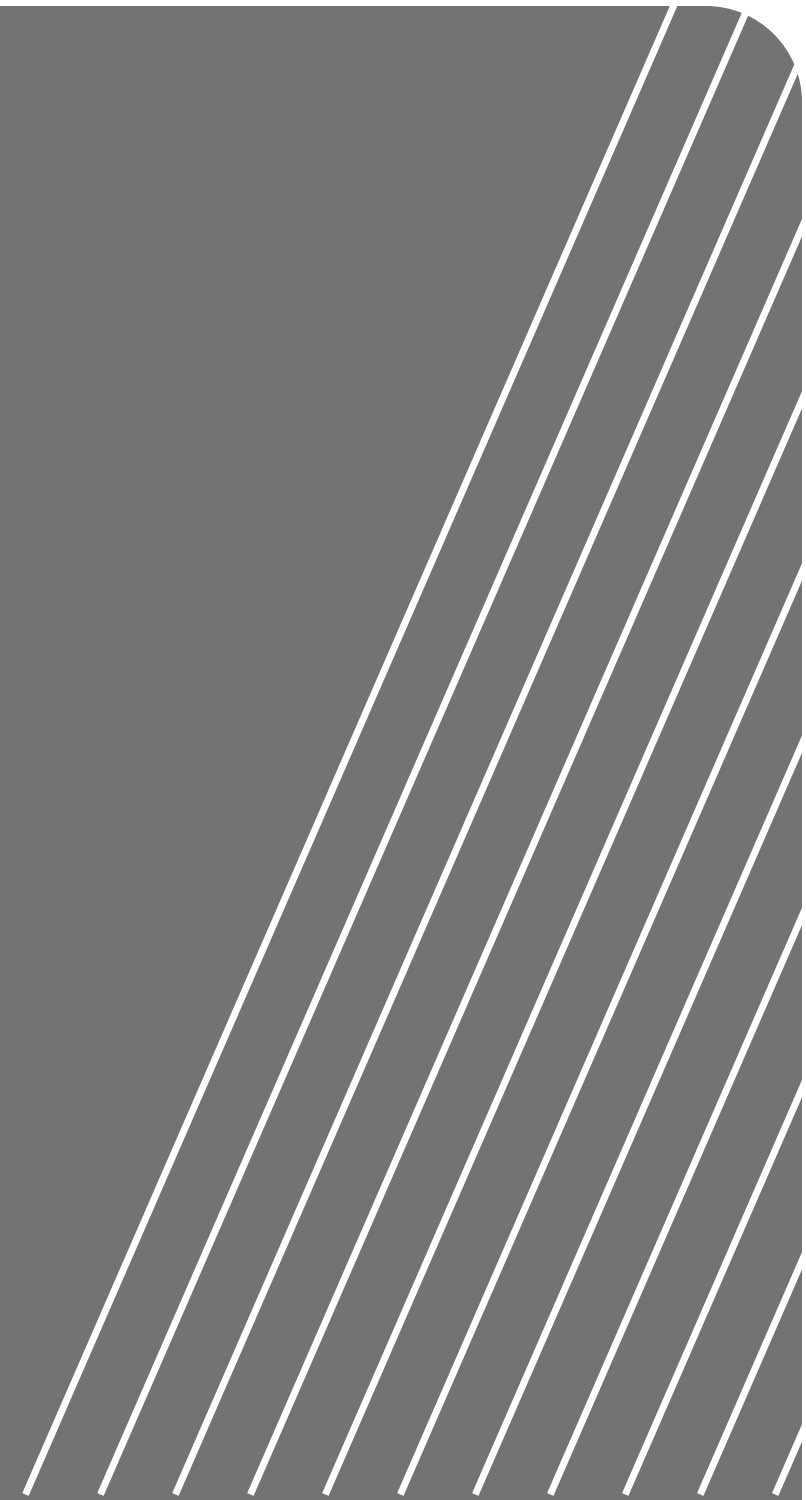
An invitation to be part of something intentional and sustainable.
